Rebecca and Tyler were struggling to have hope. They were both injured in separate car accidents and lost both of their vehicles. They found themselves unable to work for a few weeks. Rebecca was able to keep her position, but Tyler lost his job. With the lost income, they found themselves facing eviction. On top of all of this, Rebecca lost her father. They were struggling to see the light at the end of the tunnel.

Rebecca reached out to their local conference, St. Brigid. On a home visit, the Vincetians listened to their hardships and spoke with the landlord. They learned that Rebecca had maintained her job for several years, and the couple were model tenants. The Vincetians saw two people who had endured unexpected hardship. They had fallen on hard times, and simply needed a helping hand to get back on their feet.

With the help of the St. Brigid Conference, Rebecca and Tyler were able to stop the eviction and cover their back due rent. Rebecca and Tyler had hope again knowing that they were seen, heard, and cared for. The Vincetians shined Christ's light into their darkness, letting them know they were not alone.
